Schedule




Students are expected to attend classes daily from 8:30 to 3:00. During this time, students are expected to demonstrate SOAR academic behaviors (S- Self-control O- On task behaviors A-Accountability and R- Responsibility). These actions will be monitored and noted daily by teachers and support staff, however, for optimal success we will need your support to follow up upon these actions. In order to SOAR, please assure your child has cameras on during lessons. Use our platform, Schoology, to communicate with teachers and to monitor work completion. Join us when invited to discuss personalized learning and individualized Student Learning Plans.

Grading


Students and families will receive an overview from each teacher highlighting grading practices for the course or grade level within the context of the overall school grading policy. (Our grading policy is linked HERE as well as to the QR Code below. It can also be found on our website.)



All teachers will use Infinite Campus as their official grade book and will enter at least two grades per week. Parents and students can track grades using Parent Portal (http://bit.do/parentportalsteps).



Communication



We encourage all Charm City Virtual families to engage in ongoing discussions with teachers around student performance. Parents will receive two weekly forms of communication outside of date and event reminders-The Weekly Charge (Sent by Principal Casagrande) and a Weekat-a-Glance. The Weekly Charge will overview important school information, events, and celebrations and will be sent out every Monday. Week-at-a-Glances will overview what is expected of their scholar weekly and will be uploaded to our website every Friday. As grades will be updated weekly, Parent WAAGs are used to ensure all due assignments have been clearly communicated and if there is any confusion and/or questions, those can be addressed by contacting the teacher for further support.

Attendance Policy

All students are expected to attend school five days a week, for the full duration of the instructional blocks (8:30-3:00). Daily student attendance is important to learning and academic progress. After each student's absence, they should expect a phone call home. A letter will be sent after 3 absences and a letter and home visit will occur after 5 absences. If the pattern continues, an SST meeting will be scheduled in addition to the another letter and home visit will occur in addition to Students with 15 or more unexcused absences will be referred to truancy court.

To ensure students are not marked as unexcused, a written request must be submitted for documentation. CCV's absence form should be used. At the end of the form, written documentation (doctors notes or parent note), must be attached to validate the absence.

Camera Policy





Virtual Attendance <u>REQUIRES</u> cameras to be turned on:

- Students full face should be in the zoom square during class time, unless directed otherwise by the teacher.
- Students are to use school approved zoom virtual backgrounds at all times.
- A scholar can turn off background to show assignments to the teacher.
- If a student has the camera off because of a technical or family issue, an email from the parent/guardian must be sent to the teachers and administration for that day.
- Adjustable circular video frames are not allowed to be used in Zoom.

Corrective Measures

First Instance:

- Verbal prompt from teacher
- Written prompt from teacher in Chat or GoGuardian
- Student put into the waiting room and the teacher calls home

Second Instance:

- Office Referral and a call home
- Home Visit
- Hard copy of School Policy provided to parent during home visit

Third Instance:

- Office Referral
- In-School Suspension at PDC
- Meeting with parent to discuss possible removal from program



Instructional Materials



All instructional materials will be distributed in the beginning of the school year at our mandated CHARGER UNIVERSITY. This is to ensure students are provided with the supplies and materials necessary to engage in instruction. Materials are specific to students' grade level and the content being covered. While the program is designed to be virtual, we still believe all students should be provided with books to read independently, in conjunction with a lesson, and/or to support the extension of learning. While texts will be provided via virtual platforms, student texts will still be a part of distribution.

Additionally, all math manipulatives, science materials that meet at-home safety requirements, and resource class materials (fine arts, dance, Physical Education, etc), will be provided to students.

Supporting Students with Varying Learning Needs



ILPS

In alignment with the department of Gifted and Advanced Learners, all students who have tested according to the COGAT or Naglearia, will be given an ILP (Individualized Learning Plan). Similar to that of a Student Learning Plan, teachers will work with students to identify specific interests and learning styles and identify projects for our GAL students to complete. The use of Renzulli and other GAL program materials can be used to support the creation and implementation of ILPs.



STUDENT SUPPORT TEAM

Students at risk for retention/failure, students who exhibit behavior problems and/or academic concerns can be referred to the Student Support Team.

Purpose: Intensive Intervention to help the student experience success.

SST Meeting consists of:

- Sharing information about student
- Analyze root cause
- Develop a clear and measurable goal with progress monitoring

ESOL

Teachers will be provided ESOL plans for each of their ESOL students. These plans are provided by the ESOL teacher and in alignment to the their WIDA scores. The ESOL teacher, in conjunction with the classroom teacher, will provide instruction according to the students WIDA scores and area of need. The ESOL plans will provide a structured breakdown of desired outcomes which advances the overall curriculum and class goals. ESOL lessons and plans for students from beginner to intermediate levels will focus on all language skills – reading, writing, speaking, and listening.
